



MAC TeamBoard Driver Installation

The MAC TeamBoard Driver can be downloaded from the TeamBoard website.

When you have downloaded the MAC Driver you will need to extract the TeamBoard Driver using Stuffit Expander (Stuffit Expander is the MAC equivalent of WinZip on a PC). Stuffit Expander can be downloaded free of charge from the following website.

Once you have extracted the TeamBoard Driver successfully to the nominated path, you can then proceed to run the **.app** (executable file).

The application program (or executable file) that runs in MAC OS X initiates when double-clicked, similar to an **.exe** file in Windows.

The **.app** files are MAC OS X packages so you can right-click (or Control click) an application and select Show Package Contents to view the files contained in the package; these include Resources used by the application, property list (**.plist**) files, frameworks, plugins and other files.

Once the installation wizard pops up, follow the prompts and ensure that you select H-Series USB as your device. Upon completion, connect the TeamBoard USB cable and connectivity should be established. The TeamBoard should now be interactive.

MAC TeamBoard Driver Uninstall

To uninstall the TeamBoard Driver, you need to be logged into the MAC as a Root Administrator. Go to the Spotlight search function and type in **tbupddmx**. In the results, you will see a Folder of that name (**tbupddmx**). Click the Folder to open it. Scroll down until you see an application called **uninstall**. Double click the **uninstall** application, the Uninstall window will open and then click the Uninstall icon in the bottom right side of the window. The uninstall process will begin.
